 Alma Ata is the Capital of Kazakhstan, now known as Almaty.

Brief history:

The declaration of Alma Ata was adopted at the International conference on primary health care, Almaty, Kazakhstan, 6-12 september 1978. It expressed the need for urgent action by all governments, all health and development workers and the world community to protect and promote the health of all people.

Important points:

- In 1978 International conference was held at Alma Ata (USSR – Union of Soviet Socialist Republics).
- A new approach to health care came into existence as a part of movement set by World Health Assembly in 1977 i.e. Health For All by 2000.
- 3. Fundamental principle of HFA strategy is equality, that is equal health status for people and countries with an equitable distribution of health resources.

 urban poor without health care facility.
